




Detail of Responses

83.8 % of the respondent students opined that the content of the curriculum of law programme they are pursuing at the college are relevant to their chosen career and for future studies.


2. The courses (subjects) in semester system in your Programme are: 172 responses



77.9 % students informed that the courses in the semester system in their programme are well organised and objectives of the courses are clear. Whereas, 18.6 % said that these require revision.


3. Does the syllabus includes emerging and trending laws?

57 % finds that the syllabi they are studying include emerging laws, while 35.5 % say that there is need to incorporate emerging laws.


4. Do you think practical components in the curriculum need improvement. $\ensuremath{^{172}\,\text{responses}}$



60.5 % of the respondent students think that practical components in the curriculum need improvement.


5. Whether the institute's library is well equipped with the adequate books as per syllabus and other reference books?

172 responses





6. How effective is the teaching-learning process in stimulating your interest in the subject? 172 responses




When they were asked about the effectiveness of the teaching-learning process in stimulating their interest in the subject, 70.4 % students gave rating of excellent or very good.

61,6% students adjudged the effectiveness of learning during classes as excellent or very good and 26.5% found it good.


8. Do the session/classes on practical aspects of legal studies conducted regularly? 172 responses







2. The syllabus and its transaction have been:


24 responses



More than 58% are of the view that the syllabus is good while 33% or more think it to be excellent.


3. The Course outcomes are well defined and clear:

More than 62% believe course outcome is well defined and clear where as 33% or above consider it good.


4. Sufficient number of relevant reading materials and digital resources are available in the library: ^{24 responses}

5. The course has good balance between theory and application:



More than 70% believe that the course is a good blend of theory and application while more than 16% think it to be excellent.


6. The course/ Syllabus increased my knowledge in the subject area;


Above 54% faculty believes that syllabus has increased their knowledge in the subject area while more than 45% believe that they have obtained a very good knowledge from the syllabus.

7. I have the freedom to adopt new techniques/education tools/ strategies in the teaching; 24 responses




More than 70% believe that they have the excellent freedom to adopt new techniques in teaching while 25% opine that freedom given to them is very good.

8. I am able to achieve the minimum required course outcome attainment level for my class: ^{24 responses}




50% faculty believe that they have excellently obtained the minimum required course outcome while other 50% believe that they could obtain very good course outcome level for the class.

9. I have taken sufficient steps to provide assistance to slow learners: 24 responses




More than 58% believe that they have taken excellent measures in providing assistance to slow learners while above 33% believe they have taken very good measures in providing assistance to slow learners.

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
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
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1.Do you think the degree course prepared you for the professional practice in the courts. 83 responses




Around 90% students are satisfied with the Degree course prepared them for the professional practice in the courts.

2.The experience of the legal education in terms of effective curriculum and its transmission are 83 responses




The majority of students experience have been satisfactory.







Almost all the students are pleased with the extra curriculum activities in the College.


7.Do you think calling experts, for the expert lectures may enhance your knowledge on the concerned curriculum

Around 90% students are satisfied with calling experts for the expert lecture.


8. Do you think our college adequately prepared you to find a good job 83 responses
