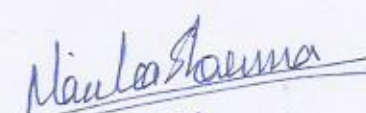

An awareness Programme on 'NRI Marriages: Do's and Don'ts, the way Forward' organized in Rayat College of Law in collaboration with the National Commission for Women, New Delhi, Department of Law, Panjab University, Chandigarh, District Legal Services Authority, Ropar and Nawanshahr and Lamrin Tech Skill University. Shri Gurvinder Singh DSP NRI Wing, SAS NAGAR discussed the various cases and remedies to prevent ourselves from this kind of marriage scam. In the end, this seminar was concluded with a vote of thanks by Dr. Manish Kumar, co-coordinator of this programme.

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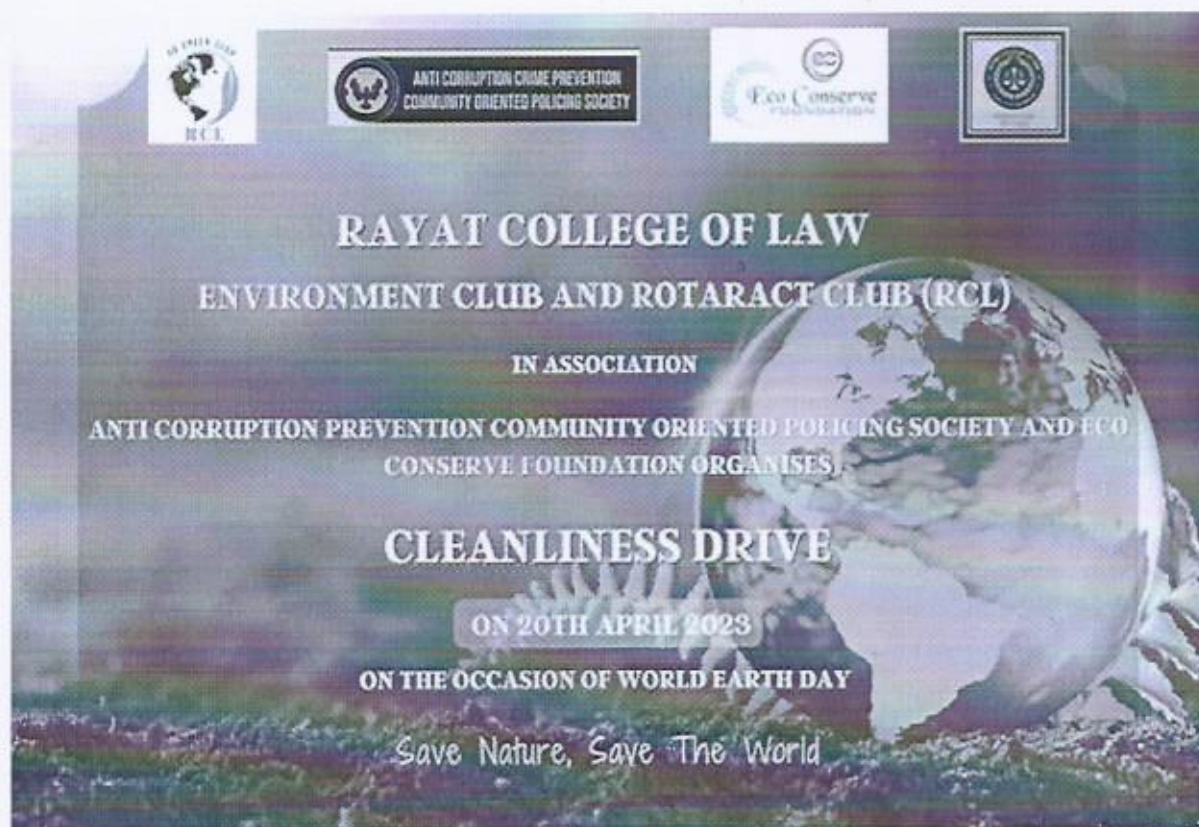


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7. Cleanliness Drive
