4. Terms and conditions

b) Usage of academic infrastructure of SDC and RCL can be allowed for limited period subject to its availability.
c) Both institutes agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from the other institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.

Reimbursement Policy Draft for MOU:

As per the norms the host college reimburses the visiting faculties/Resource persons towards the Travel Allowance(T.A), Dearness Allowance(D.A), Local Travel and Honorarium (if any) as per rules.

Duration of MOU:

The duration of this MOU shall be for a period of three years from the effective date.

Each party agrees that it shall not, at any time, during or after executing the activities of this MOU, disclose any information in relation to these activities or the affairs of mentorship program without the express consent of both parties. Any sensitive topics that are discussed will be held in the highest confidence.

Entirety of Understanding

This MOU contains the final and entire understanding between the parties, and all future projects or agreements shall be in a separate writing based upon mutual agreement of the parties, and neither the parties nor their agents shall be bound by any terms, conditions, statements, warranties, or representations, either oral or written, not herein contained.

Governing Law: This MOU and all issues arising out of the same shall be construed in accordance with the laws of India.

Arbitration

Any dispute arising with regard to any aspect of this MOU shall be settled through mutual consultations and agreements by the parties to the MOU.



2. Collaboration in Legal Aid Awareness camps and other awareness campaigns of mutual interest.
3. Engage students and scholars in internship programmes.
4. Provide free of cost mutual access to facilities available for purpose of awareness programmes.

2. Motivate students to undergo various campaigns and training programme organised by ACCP-COPS.
3. Logo on all online and offline modes of promotion of the event jointly organised by the college and ACCP-COPS.

MODE OF OPERATION

Both the parties will provide necessary support for the effective implementation of the MoU within the institutional rules and procedures.

This MoU shall be effective from the date it is signed by both the parties.

Within the broad frame work of the MoU Anti Corruption Crime Prevention Community Oriented Policing Society (ACCP –COPS) (Regd.) and Rayat College of Law can work on awareness activities, internship programmes, development of facilities etc.

Any financial commitment for joint activities under this MoU shall be subject to the approval by the competent authorities of the respective organisation.

The activities under this MoU shall be coordinated, monitored and recorded by an Internal Coordination Committee. President ACCP-COPS, shall be the internal coordinator from ACCP-COPS whereas Principal, RCL will be the internal coordinator from RCL.

The visitors will be bound by the rules and regulations, as well as the code of conduct of the host institution.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This MoU places no financial obligation or supplementary funding commitments on either party. These activities will be defined through separate programme agreements, detailing the commitments of resources (financial or otherwise) required from each institution. Subsequent program agreements must be approved in advance in writing by the authorised representatives from both parties. Each party will be responsible for its own costs in common connection with

all matters relating to collaborations under the MoU. Where possible and appropriate, the parties may also seek funding for collaborations from Government and related agencies. This MoU is also on broad based understanding between the parties and does not place any financial liabilities on any of the parties. In case there is joint financial involvement between both the parties for any awareness activities it would be decided on event basis in advance.

VALIDITY

The Memorandum shall remain in force for a period of two years commencing from effective date.
