motivated the students to maintain a proper personal hygiene. She said that maintaining personal hygiene kept the diseases away and also motivated the students to follow good practices.



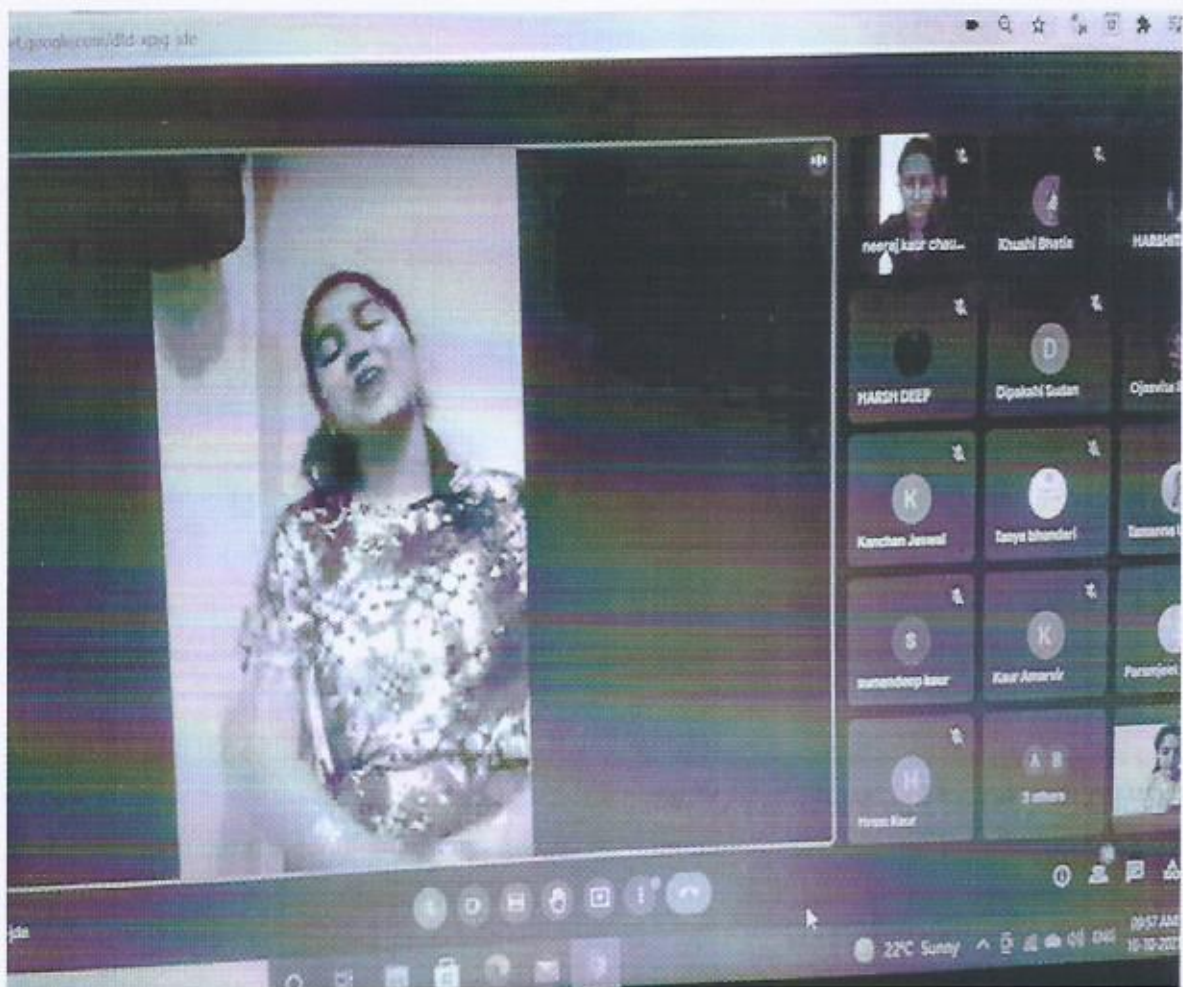
Poem Recitation Competition Under Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav on 16/10/2021



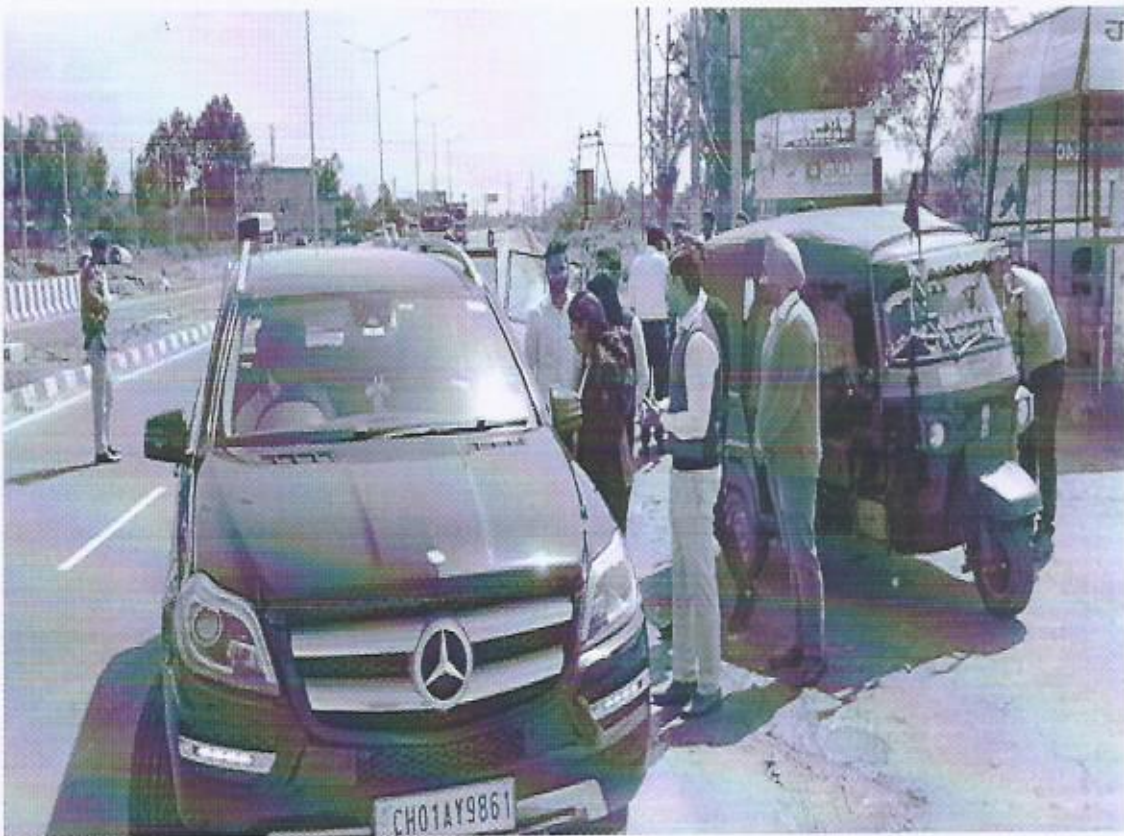
Legal Awareness Campaign for Road Safety on 14/03/2020

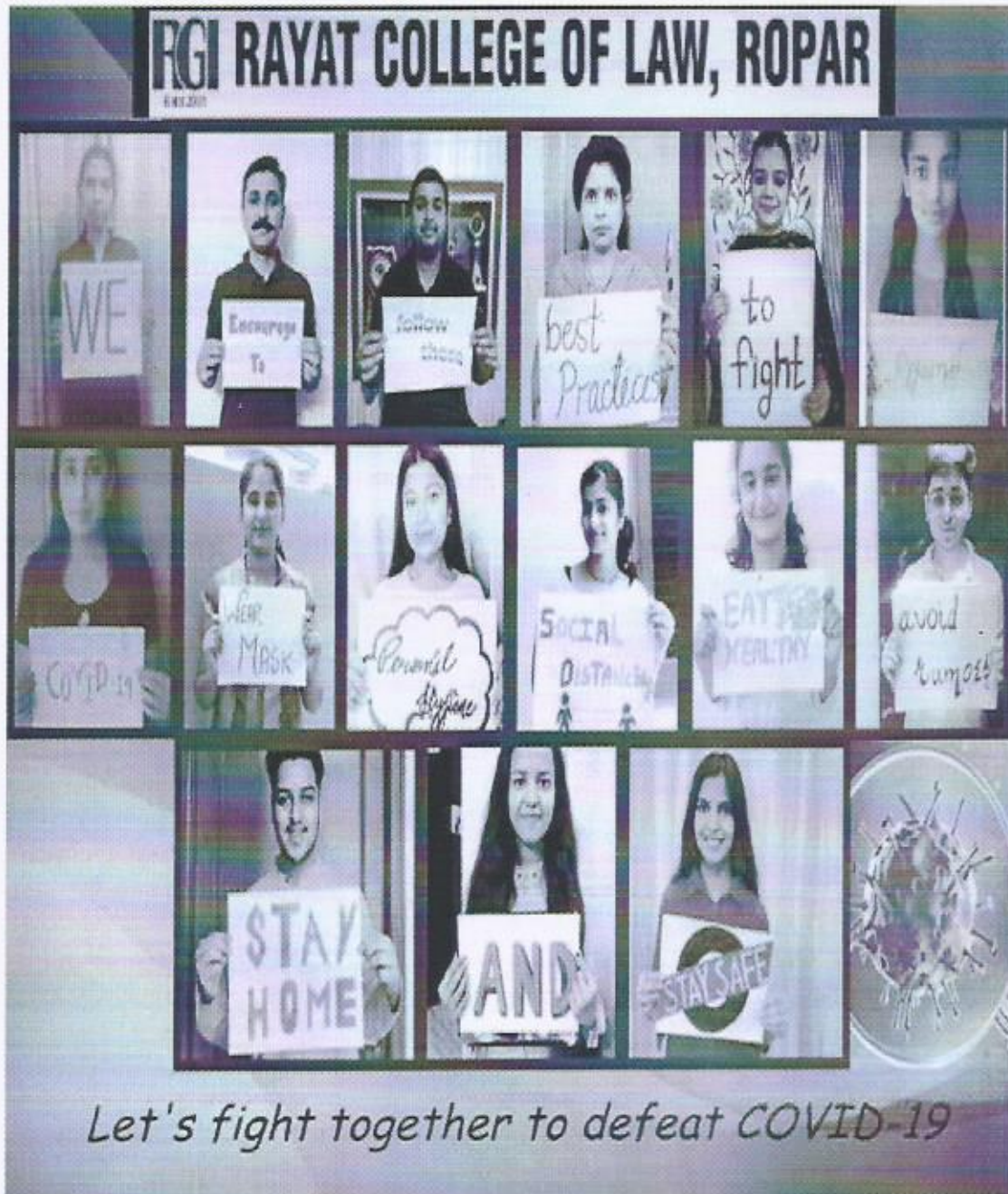
