- The day concluded with the dinner followed by planning for the next day.

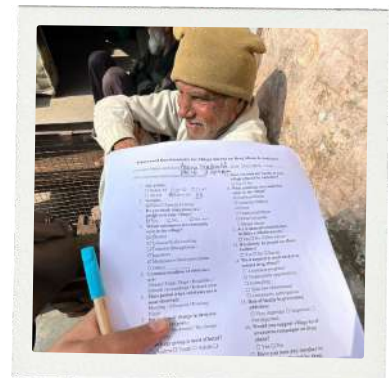
