HISTORY

The National Service Scheme (NSS) was established in India on **September 24, 1969**, to commemorate the birth centenary of Mahatma Gandhi.

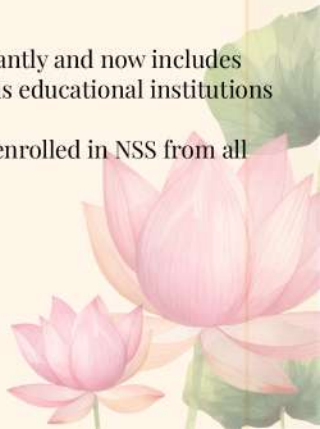
The idea behind NSS was to involve students in the task of national service, thereby fostering a sense of social responsibility and community engagement.

The scheme was launched under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports.

The origins of NSS can be traced back to the recommendations of the Education Commission (1964-66), headed by **Dr. D.S. Kothari**, which suggested that students should engage in some form of social service. The scheme was initially introduced in **37 universities**, involving **40,000 students**.

Over the years, NSS has expanded significantly and now includes millions of student volunteers from various educational institutions across the country.

At present there are over **37 Lakh volunteers** enrolled in NSS from all regions of the country.

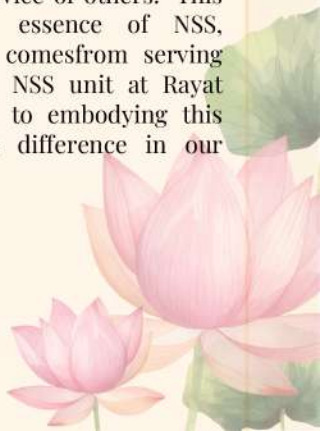


NSS - MOTO

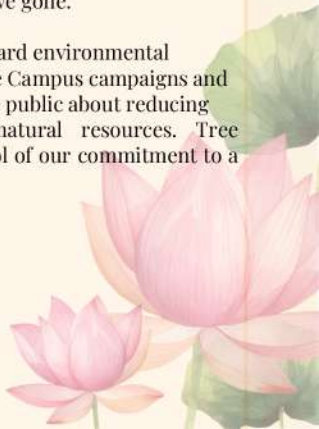
FROM THE PROGRAM OFFICER'S DESK....

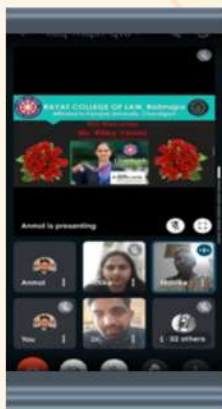

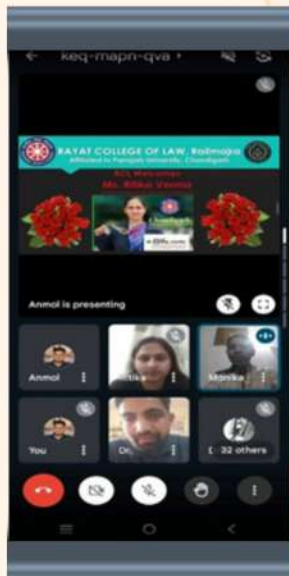
